

EXAMPLES OF CONTENTS NOTES

If you wouldn't make a title added entry for it, don't enhance it:

No. 1 in F major, BWV 1046 -- No. 3 in G major, BWV 1048 -- No. 4 in G major, BWV 1049.

Sonata no. 3 -- Concerto for flute and orchestra -- Four trios.
