MISSISSIPPI VALLEY LIBRARY DISTRICT OPENS FAIRMONT BRANCH

The Mississippi Valley Library District has seen many changes in the last number of years. To better serve the people living in the outlying areas of the district, they will be opening the Fairmont City Library Center.

Starting in June and following through to July, the MVLD has teamed with Holy Rosary Parish in Fairmont City to bring a temporary library that can bring better service to Fairmont City and State Park residents.

The Fairmont City Library Center will open its doors on June 3rd at 10:00 a.m. in the Holy Rosary School's Primary Building at 2727 N. 43rd Street in Fairmont City.

The Fairmont City Library Center will then continue to be open from Tuesday through Thursday 10am to 6pm and Friday and Saturday 9am to 5pm for every week through June and July. The Library Center will be closed on Sundays and Mondays of each week and will also close on June 20th and 21st for the Village's picnic and on July 4th. Otherwise, the Library will be open and the staff ready to serve.

Activities include: cataloging/editing of materials; searching online databases for appropriate bibliographic information; authority control work; and other tasks related to successful completion of the inventory.
2. Works with other staff involved with Illinois documents, including staff working on electronic access through Electronic Documents of Illinois, to address needed priorities for cataloging of electronic materials.
3. Develop procedures and documentation for metadata creation and tracking.
