### IMLS RELEASES FY 07 STATE LIBRARY AGENCY DATA

The Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) is pleased to announce the early release of data on state library agencies in the 50 states and the District of Columbia for state fiscal year (FY) 2007. The data were collected through the State Library Agencies (StLA) Survey, a voluntary survey conducted annually by IMLS. The FY 2007 StLA Survey is the 14th in the series.

The FY 2007 survey collected data on 278 items, including state library agency identification, governance, public service hours, service outlets, collections, library service transactions, library development transactions, services to other libraries in the state, allied operations, staff, revenue, expenditures, and electronic services and information. The survey's 100 percent response rate results from the cooperative effort between the Chief Officers of

State Library Agencies (COSLA), IMLS, and the Census Bureau.

The early data release will be followed later this fall with the State Library Agency Report for FY 2007, which includes findings, background information, and tables providing an overview of state library agencies.
