

## Sound Recording Series

If a book and an audiocassette have the same series, the series for the sound must be qualified by (Sound recording). The qualifier is used only when the series have the same title.

Example for book :

440;0 ;a Men at war ; \$v 002

Example for audiobook:

490;1 ;a Men at war ; \$v 002

830; 0;a Men at war (Sound recording) ; \$v 002.

Example for book:

490;1 ;a Canadian West series ; \$v bk. 002

800;1 ;a Oke, Janette, \$d 1935- ; \$t Canadian West series ; \$v bk.  
002.

Example for audiobook:

490;1 ;a Canadian west series ; \$v bk. 002

800;1 ;a Oke, Janette, \$d 1935- \$t Canadian West series  
(Sound recording) ; \$v bk. 002.
